CO-ED TEMPORARY RESIDENCES FOR HOMELESS YOUTH

NASSAU HAVEN

Nassau Haven is a 12 bed co-ed emergency shelter, providing short-term housing and case management services to runaway and homeless youth in Nassau County, ages 10 to 20 years.

Nassau Haven is a voluntary program. Residents work with staff to address those issues and problems which resulted in the need for housing and services. Youths must agree to accept services and to rules and responsibilities of the home and follow guidelines of program.

WALKABOUTS

Walkabouts for Young Men and Women are transitional houses in Freeport and Uniondale, serving homeless adolescents. They provide young people, ages 16 – 20, with short-term housing and services for up to eighteen months in order to prepare them for living independently in the community.

Residence in the program is voluntary.

Residents are expected to fulfill the guidelines of the program and actively plan for either living independently in the community or returning home to their family.

SERVICES

- Assistance with securing appropriate, long-term housing or resolving family conflict so the youth may return home
- A direct link to the Family Mediation Project. Family Mediators are available to discuss any issues or difficulties facing a youth and their family
- Respite Housing offers families and youths an opportunity to take a break from one another to avert or address crises
- Case management services to guide young people and help them access the services they need in the community
- Educational and vocational assistance
- Medical and mental health resources

SERVICES

- Vocational and educational planning, assessment and assistance
- Individual and group counseling on a weekly basis
- Family intervention whenever possible
- Group projects and recreational activities
- Medical and mental health resources are made available
- Aftercare services include supportive counseling, referral services, and scholarship assistance
